

## NDULUKU BIBLE INSTITUTE REPAIRS PROJECT

Those of you who follow us personally or via our mailings know that we have gone to Kenya numerous times and have worked with our son, James, who has put us in touch with several godly African leaders, many trained by him at Scott Theological College.

One of these men is Benjamin Nzwili. This past year he became the principal of the Nduluku Bible Institute, a couple of hours Southeast of Nairobi. Our church in Moreland has a sister church near Taveta. When the Mukutano pastor's wife expressed an interest in going to Bible School so she could better serve her church and community, the Moreland church provided funding for her to go to the Nduluku Bible Institute. Although the students pay a small fee, most of the school's operations are funded through local gifts. Very little funding comes from the U.S.

While in Kenya during April 2009, Benjamin took us to the school. When we saw the run down condition of the campus our hearts were touched by the desperate need he has for some people to come alongside him to help him with repairs. At David's request, Benjamin responded by sending a list of projects along with the financial needs to complete them. David is asking God to provide some men to go along with him to help with three projects listed below, preferably in February or March 2010.

1. Proposed water harvesting, which means installing gutters on the buildings, constructing bases for holding tanks, setting holding (catching) tanks.
2. Install a fence around the property using chain link fencing, barbed wire plus installing concrete pillars.
3. Repair buildings - replacing window panes, (there are lots of them), classroom repairs & painting.

He is requesting finances to cover the material costs plus team expenses while there, which means that the money for materials & team expenses need to be in place before a team can go.

1. Water Harvesting materials		\$2050.
